



From Zug train station, "Metalli / Bahnhof" bus stop, take the ZVB line 603, every 15 minutes, directly to the "Schönegg" valley station.

Please note: The number of parking spaces at the Schönegg valley station is limited. Further parking in the "Casino" multi-storey car park, then continue by bus line 603 from the "Casino" bus stop to the Schönegg valley station. Buy your ticket directly to Zugerberg. (Return = 1 day ticket)

### Hike 1 - also for small hikers

The trail goes mostly through the forest.

### Hike 5 - downhill with view

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Institut Montana / Schönfels – Blasenberg – Schönegg, ZBB valley station

### 1 hour 25 min.

Beautiful vantage points over Lake Zug, the city of Zug and the surrounding area

# Hike 6 - panorama included

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Institut Montana / Schönfels – Blasenberg – Steren – St. Verena - Zug, SBB railway station

### 1 hour 30 min.

Beautiful vantage points at Steren

### Hike 7 - view, forest and meadows

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Institut Montana / Schönfels – Blasenberg – Rägeten – Zug, SBB railway station

### 1 hour 30 min.

Very beautiful scenic hiking trail with short forest sections

### Hike 8 - forest hike to Oberwil

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Altenboden – Unter Horbach – Mättli – Mülibachbrücke – Klinik Zugersee – Oberwil

### 1 hour 35 min.

Most of the route leads through the forest (natural roads).

### Hike 9 - from mountain to lake

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Altenboden – Ober Horbach – Tossetschwändi – Schwändeli – Gibel – Walchwil, boat station

### 2 hours 10 min.

Beautiful vantage point near Ober Horbach

### Hike 10 - downhill in the forest

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Vordergeissboden – Hünggigütsch-Sätteli – Räbrüti – Fiselstuden – Nollengatter – Wissenschwändi – Unterägeri, ZVB bus stop

### 2 hours 20 min.

Various fireplaces and shelters

# Hike 11 – easy summer tour



Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Vordergeissboden – Hünggigütsch-Sätteli – Boden – Unterägeri, ZVB bus stop

### 1 hour 15 min.

Beautiful vantage points after Ägeri; pleasant even at high temperatures.

Pram and wheelchair accessible

### Hike 12 - towards the Lorze

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Vordergeissboden – Hochwacht – Bilgerighof – Allenwinden – Wildenburg – Lorzentobelbrücke – Höllgrotten / Höll – Baar, SBB railway station

### 3 hours

Worthwhile detour to the Wildenburg ruins or to the Höllgrotten caves Shady resting places along the Lorze river

### Hike 13 - also the smallest ones are there

# Hike 14 - uphill and downhill

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Vordergeissboden – Hünggigütsch-Sätteli – Räbrüti – Buschenchappeli – Alpli – Urzlenboden – Cholerhütte – Brandhöchi – Unterägeri, ZVB bus stop

### 4 hours 20 min.

The route leads along relaxing forest paths.

# Hike 15 - the royal stage

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Ewegstafel – Früebüel – Buschenchappeli – Alpli – Ober Rossberg – Gnipen – Wildspitz

### 3 hours 40 min.

7 hours

The Wildspitz is the highest point (1,580 m above sea level) in Canton Zug and offers a fantastic panoramic view.

# Hike 16 - over the Wildspitz

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Vordergeissboden – Hünggigütsch-Sätteli – Räbrüti – Buschenchappeli – Alpli – Wildspitz – Halsegg – Sattel, SOB railway station

# Hike 17 - from Wildspitz to Schwyz

Zugerberg, ZBB mountain station – Ewegstafel – Früebüel – Balisbrugg – Stafel – Rufiberg – Steinerberg, SOB railway station

Beautiful vantage points over Lake Zug, Arth and the surrounding area

The Zugerberg Trail stretches over 2.1 km with an average gradient of 16 % and 340 metres. The trail is full of curves, jumps, wallrides and much more. There are bypasses for all obstacles, so the trail offers exciting options for cyclists of all levels.




Young visitors associate the Zugerberg above all with Zugiblubbi of the Moor – the friendly spirit of the Zugerberg.


### Schattwäldli adventure play area

The Schattwäldli adventure play area is perfect for an enjoyable family day or a relaxing break while hiking. The play area can be easily reached with a pram and is located on the edge of the forest, about 20 minutes from the Zugerberg mountain station.

The circular walks Rabbit, Fox and Stag (page 7) and the adventure trail (page 16) all lead past the adventure play area.

### **Fireplaces**

- Buschenchappeli\*: Lies in an idyllic location on the Walchwilerberg
- Fiselstuden: Situated on the edge of the forest
- Ewegstafel: Lies a little off the beaten track on a small high plateau
- Brand\*: Two large fireplaces with magnificent views, directly on the adventure trail, with loungers, photo frame and marble run
- Schattwäldli\*: Offers idyllic shaded areas as well as toilets and running water.
- Hünggigütsch-Sätteli\*: With a view of the lake and mountains from afar
- Lärchenbrüggli: Wonderful view of Lake Zug
- Schwanden: Lies in the forest shortly before the Schönegg valley station


